GUEST SPEAKERS

Carlee Martin – Vice President of Gas Supply at Gas Alberta Inc. (Speech attached)

Questions/Comments:

Dennis Duncan: Will the market be affected if there is a major line to the coast? Yes, the market price reflects gas supply to the coast. Currently, there are field receipts waiting to come on line for that demand. There is a question on how much is waiting (offset). A ton of production has come on and we are seeing record high field receipts in anticipation of the LNG facilities.

Murray Ormberg – Are there any Co-ops supply terminated or jeopardized, and if so, how are you supplying? No supply terminations, but if there is an outage of peroration, emergency suppliers would be called from providers that have LNG trucks. One huge strength Gas Alberta has in order to buy from suppliers, they require credit, GAI doesn't have assets or true balance sheets, that gas supply agreement is if one gas co-op goes down, others co-ops (75 in total) will come in provide support. This provides credit strength. Murray Ormberg: Thought there were some cases where major pipelines were abandoning pipe and the supply jeopardized: Yes, but this provides co-ops with an opportunity to buy pipelines. There is a current program with TC energy that looks at the integrity, and if they want to purchase or build on the infrastructure. Gas Alberta Inc provides support.

Bert Paulssen: In Canada/Alberta, we are not eligible for carbon credits. If we had a coal fired electrical plant and converted it to natural gas, we are not granted credits. In recent discussions with the Premier, we are trying to get the Federal Government to provide us with credits for any



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natural gas exported out of AB and across the globe. If coal plants were converted, the planet warming and climate change conversation would not exist. Some good news, BC just approved LNG export to be built. This past winter when temperatures hit -40, a grid alert was broadcasted when that the electrical grid was crashing. At that time, statistics showed that natural gas was generating 80% of the energy needed to supply the province. We need to get the understanding out there that natural gas is the cleanest burning fossil fuel compared to other fuels.
