If there are ever issues with your gas account, GLDC Gas will contact you directly. However, you should be cautious of any unsolicited messages, even if they claim to be from us. If you receive suspicious communication claiming to be from GLDC Gas, the safest course of action is to contact our office directly to verify its legitimacy.

Effective April 1, 2025 the new carbon tax rate will be \$ 4.863/GJ

Bill Payment Options

Equalized Payment: This allows members to pay a fixed monthly amount based on their average annual gas consumption starting May 1st.

To qualify, members must have at least one year of prior gas usage history.

Gas bills are payable in person at the G.L.D.C. Gas Co-op office by cheque, cash or debit; and in person at banking facilities.

Pre-Authorized Auto Debit:

Provide authorization with a copy of a VOID cheque.

CARBON TAX IMPACT INCREASE EFFECTIVE APRIL 1, 2025

These rates are prescribed by the Government of Canada on an increasing scale and are scheduled to increase by \$15 per tonne per year, rising to **\$95 per tonne on April 1, 2025**.

Following engagement with provinces, territories and Indigenous leaders, the minimum price on carbon pollution (for direct pricing systems) will **increase by \$15 per tonne per year starting in 2023 through to 2030**.

Natural Gas Utilities are required to charge these rates as per the federal Greenhouse Gas Pollution Pricing Act. All fees charged under this Act are remitted directly to Revenue Canada.
